#### Mechanics

- The call is open to all who have abstract academic papers/research studies based on the conference theme and subthemes.
- In case of the online open sessions, Youtube broadcasting is mandatory because of the internet speed.
- Individual Youtube video creation & broadcasting fee  
(High-income countries, USD300/Students USD120, Middle-, USD200/80; Low-, USD100/40)
- Offline/Broadcasting: Jeju Island, Jeju, Korea  
(Offline participation fee: KRW150,000/Students 75,000)
- By submitting manuscripts, authors give consent to and ASIP to use, reproduce, publish and if applicable, edit, their names, photographs, images, all personal and other information, and any videos and other audio-visual or written material and documents submitted by the author, for purposes related to this presentation.

## Abstract submission

- Abstracts must be original and must NOT have been published/submitted for publication or scheduled for presentation.
- *Deadline for submission is on **September 12, 2021**.*
- Contact [asip.society@innovationandpolicy.asia](mailto:asip.society@innovationandpolicy.asia) to submit abstract. After the review process, authors will be notified about the acceptance of their Abstract from September 13, 2021.
- Abstracts have to be in English and follow the APA formatting and style guide.
- Format: Arial, 11-point, single-spaced, 1-inch (2.5 cm) margin all around, and A4 page setting.
- It must be accompanied by a cover page with name/s of author(s), contact phone number(s), and e-mail addresses.
- Must be submitted in PDF.

## Conference Presentations

- The finalists are given the opportunity to present their paper during the 11th ASIP International Conference on October 7-9, 2021.
- *All of the presentation materials should be sent to [asip.society@innovationandpolicy.asia](mailto:asip.society@innovationandpolicy.asia) by **September 26, 2021**.*
- In principle, 20 mins presentation and 10 mins discussion will be given to each presenter.

## Prizes

- Three types of awards: Best Presentation, Best Student Presentation and Best Creative Presentation.
- All three winners will get the chance to have their research paper published in the Asian Journal of Innovation and Policy (AJIP).
- Winners will be announced and awarded during the gala dinner on October 8, 2021.
